

St. Barnabas was founded in 1872

Legacy focuses on what will endure. It is about passing on things of lasting value to those who will live on after us. Legacy involves living intentionally and aiming to build into the next generations for their success.

Bequests are generally used to improve the physical building and/or financial circumstances of a church beyond what annual pledges can do. Because it is usually not possible to predict the needs or priorities of a church at the time of one's death (since we don't know when we will die), usually the best thing is to make your request undesignated. This gives the Vestry the greatest flexibility in applying your gift in accordance with the needs and priorities of the church at the time of your death.

Memorial gifts are often given at the time of a person's death instead of flowers. It is a way to say that the person was important and will be missed. But memorial gifts do not always have to come at a person's death. Some people also like to make memorial gifts on the anniversary of someone's death or at other times in remembrance of someone close. Some gifts can be given to honor someone who is still alive. It is a celebration of one's life at an anniversary, birthday, or just to say thanks. Gifts are always welcomed and appreciated even though they/you may no longer worship at St. Barnabas.
